CAMERAS ROLLING AT 20TH-FOX TELEVISION
ON ELEVENTH--AND LAST--M*A*S*H SEASON

Principal photography begins Friday (Sept. 10) on the 11th and final season of the award-winning and ratings grabbing 20th Century-Fox television series, "M*A*S*H."

The final season will consist of 15 new half-hour shows (six of which were filmed before the last hiatus in April) and a two-hour special in which the Korean Police Action ends in a cease-fire and the 4077th Mobil Army Surgical Hospital is disbanded.

All seven stars who finished season number 10 will return for the final year, including Alan Alda, Mike Farrell, Harry Morgan, Loretta Swit, David Ogden Stiers, Jamie Farr and William Christopher.

Executive Producer Burt Metcalfe, who has been with "M*A*S*H" through every episode ever filmed, announced that the finale, entitled "Goodbye, Farwell and Amen," will be directed by Alda.

Special permission was obtained from the Writer's Guild so that the writing credits on the last show will include Metcalfe, Alda, supervising producer John Rappaport, producers Thad Mumford and Dan Wilcox, executive story consultant Karen Hall and the writing team of Elias Davis and David Pollock.
